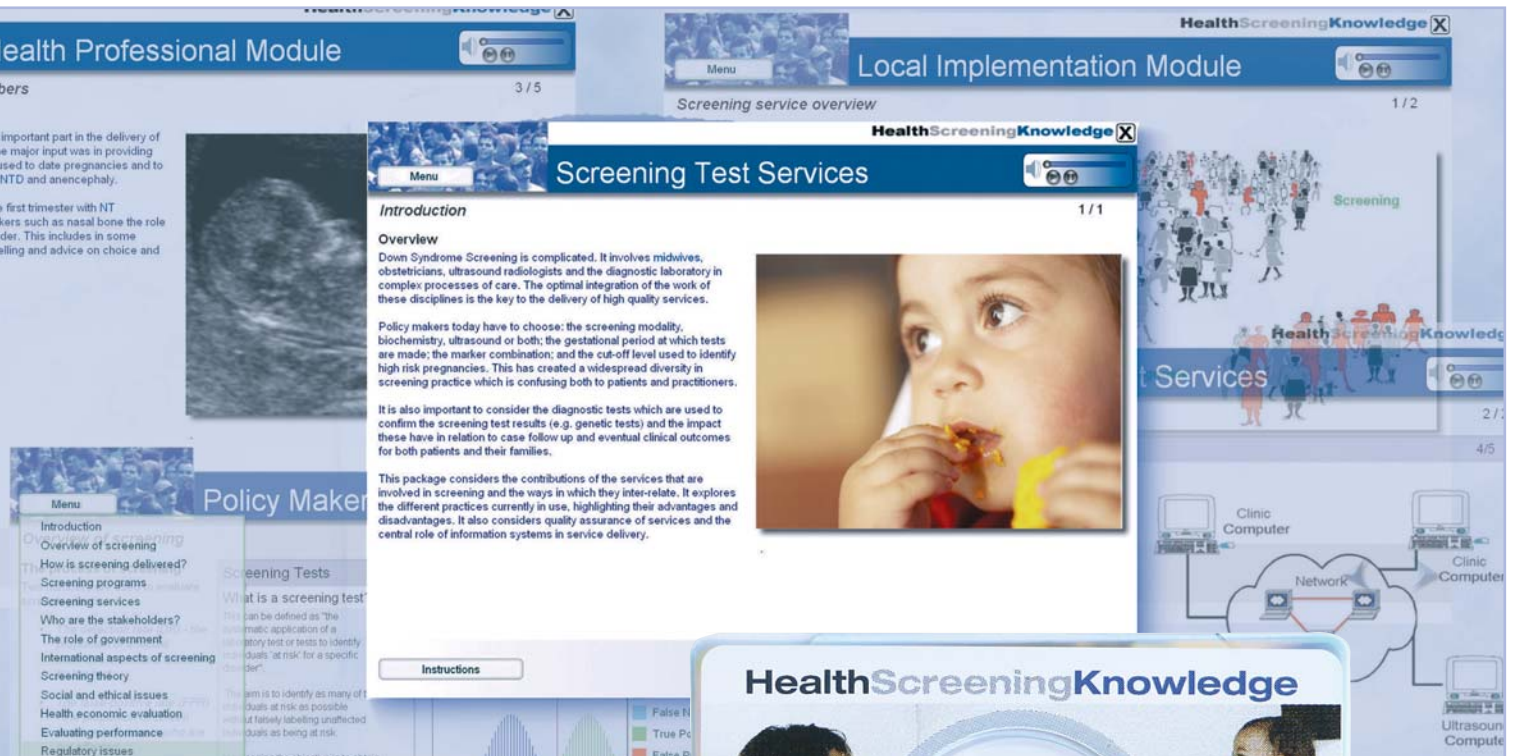

What the HealthScreening Knowledge multimedia pack contains

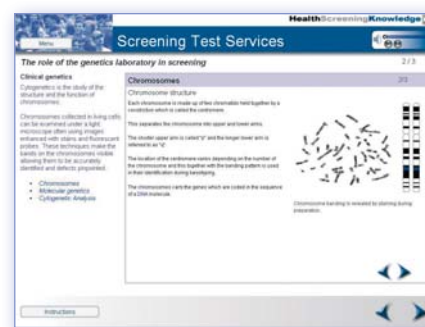
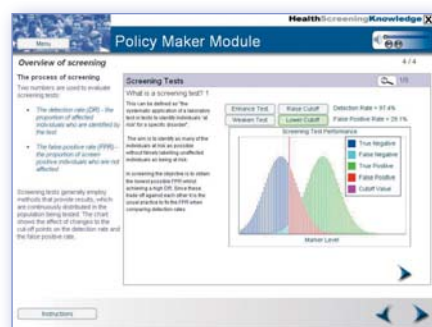
